

The Faulkner murals in the National Archives Rotunda include an artist's representation of the Signing of the Declaration of Independence and the drafting of the U.S. Constitution. The murals depict the founding fathers but no women. The National Archives Foundation commissioned artist Samara King of Port Townsend, Washington, to bring equality to the murals with the addition of Abigail Adams, Dolley Madison, Martha Washington and Eliza Hamilton to ensure that, "We remember the ladies!"
