In the course of considering how to handle [REDACTED] letter, this office contacted FBI Special Agent [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] [REDACTED] solely to determine the accuracy of [REDACTED] representations. Special Agent [REDACTED] was very helpful, and advised us that [REDACTED] who himself has been convicted of passing bad checks, had misused letters of commendation in the past in an effort to obtain a bank loan. Accordingly, we have not responded to [REDACTED] in any fashion.
