The Office creates and maintains over a thousand charts covering 95,000 miles of shoreline and 3.4 million square nautical miles of water. In addition, supports the 1.3 billion metric tons of cargo valued at \$1.8 trillion that comes in and out of U.S. ports every year. The Office of Coast Survey publishes a publication called United States Coast Pilot. Topics in the Coast Pilot include channel descriptions, anchorages, bridge and cable clearances, currents, tide and water levels, prominent features, pilotage, towage, weather, ice conditions, wharf descriptions, dangers, routes, traffic separation schemes, small-craft facilities, and Federal regulations applicable to navigation.
