(a) ACTIVE PERMANENT POSITIONS, DAY-FORWARD AND LEGACY. NOTATING THE CHANGES: The "Summary of Changes from previous submission" field includes a drop-down list of possible changes that may have occurred since the previous submission. This field helps facilitate review of the new submission by NARA. Please select the scenario that is most appropriate. Most positions being carried forward from a previously approved form can likely be noted as "No change."
