In part, the Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act (EEOICPA) of 2000 provides additional monetary compensation to uranium workers (or their eligible survivors) awarded under the Radiation Exposure Compensation Act (RECA). The compensation may include a lump-sum compensation payment, medical benefits, and lost wages.

The EEOICPA is administered by the Department of Labor (DOL) and the RECA is administered by the Department of Justice (DOJ). The DOJ is required to provide DOL with evidence necessary to adjudicate EEOICPA claims. Class 211 cases contain documents sent and received by the DOJ in fulfillment of this legal obligation.
