The Crime Victims' Rights Act of 2004, 18 U.S.C. § 3771, sets forth the rights of a victim of a federal crime to file a complaint against any employee of the Department of Justice who violated or failed to provide the rights established under the Act.

The Department of Justice has established the Office of the Victims' Rights Ombudsman to receive and investigate complaints filed by crime victims against its employees, and has implemented "Procedures to Promote Compliance with Crime Victims' Rights Obligations," 28 C.F.R. § 45.10.

The complaint process is not designed for the correction of specific victims' rights violations, but is instead used to request corrective or disciplinary action against Department of Justice employees who may have failed to provide rights to crime victims. The Department of Justice will investigate the allegations in the complaint to determine whether the employee utilized his or her "best efforts" to provide crime victims' rights. The Office of the Victims' Rights Ombudsman does not administer crime victim funds or provide services.
