Each Marine Highway rou is designated by the Secretary of the U.S. Dept. of Transportation (U.S. DOT). MARAD maintains a geodatabase containing the routing information for all designated Marine Highway routes.

Routing information for each route corresponds to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' (USACE) North American Waterway Network. The geodatabase is updated annually to include any additions to the system and the most recent tonnage data for each route. All tonnage data for the Marine Highway routes is derived from published USACE reports/datasets. The America's Marine Highway Network geodatabase is included in the National Transportation Atlas Database (NTAD). Although this dataset appears in NTAD, it belongs to MARAD and MARAD is solely responsible for it's content and maintenance. The Marine Highway System is a subset of the USACE Waterway Network and only includes waterways that have been designated by the Secretary of Transportation as routes that are likely to support the movement of domestic freight and relive landside congestion. A few of the designated marine highway routes do not correspond to the USACE Waterway Network and are entirely unique to MARAD. This dataset is also unique and that it solely highlights routes that contribute to a reduction in landside congestion.
