The NRAB operates under the National Mediation Board, although except for budgetary and general administrative direction it acts as a separate entity. The National Railroad Adjustment Board is divided into four Divisions, consisting of equal numbers of representatives of the carriers and of national organizations of employees. Each Division has jurisdiction over certain crafts or classes of The Divisions have always operated as distinct units with their own policies and
