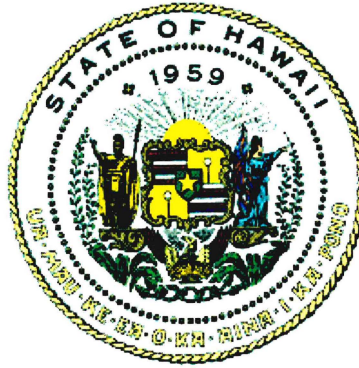

Pursuant to the Laws of the United States

I, JOSH GREEN, M.D., Governor of the State of Hawaii, do hereby certify that the returns of votes cast for Electors of President and Vice President of the United States of America, for the State of Hawaii, at an election held therein for that purpose, on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November, in the year of our Lord two thousand and twenty-four, agreeably to the provisions of the laws of the said State, and in conformity with the Constitution and laws of the United States, for the respective terms prescribed by the Constitution of the United States, to begin on the twentieth day of January in the year of our Lord two thousand and twenty-five, were, ascertained on the twenty-fifth day of November A.D. two thousand and twenty-four, and that the list of persons voted for and the number of votes cast for each, respectively, is as follows:

If a substitute elector is appointed to fill a vacancy, the governor shall submit an amended certificate of ascertainment stating the names on the final list of the State's electors.
