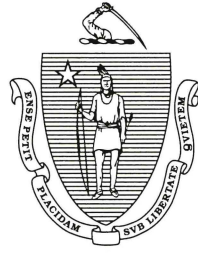

have been duly chosen and appointed Electors of the President and Vice President of the United States of America for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, at an election for that purpose held therein on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in November, being the fifth day of said month, in the year two thousand and twenty-four agreeably to the provisions of the laws of said Commonwealth, and in conformity with the constitution and laws of the United States, for the purpose of giving in their votes for President and Vice President of the United States, for the respective terms prescribed by the constitution of the United States, to begin at noon on the twentieth day of January, in the year two thousand and twenty-five.

And I further certify that the votes at said election for Electors of President and Vice President of the United States, as appears by the returns from the several cities and towns in this Commonwealth, which were duly received and examined by the Governor and Council, on the fourth day of December, in accordance with law were as follows:
