Charlie has 23 years in industry from the intelligence analyst to CEO level in small, medium and large businesses. He served in the federal government as the Deputy Assistant Director for Special Security and Program Executive for Security Clearance Reform at the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI). He established and led the DNI's Security Executive Agent national policy and oversight office responsible for the \$5B+ USG security clearance enterprise. He also served as Senior Advisor to the DNI for Personnel Security issues. He was appointed as a Senior National Intelligence Service (SNIS) officer in 2008.
