We await your full report as stated in your letter within the next 30 calendar days. Please ensure that this report includes further details as outlined in 36 CFR 1230.14:

- A complete description of the records with volume and dates;
- A statement of the exact circumstances surrounding the removal, defacing, alteration, or destruction of records:
- A statement of the safeguards established to prevent further loss of documentation; and
- Details of the actions taken to salvage, retrieve, or reconstruct the records.

The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) received the Department of the Interior (DOI) Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM) letter dated October 25, 2024, regarding the potential unauthorized disposition of six boxes containing Bid Appeal Analysis, National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Compliance for Lease Sale, Development and Production Plans and Related Permits, and NEPA Compliance for Programmatic Issues records that may have been lost during shipment from the Sterling, VA Iron Mountain commercial records storage facility to the Washington National Records Center (WNRC).

Recently, NARA received documentation from DOI BOEM that indicates the missing boxes were located and successfully shipped from Iron Mountain to the WNRC on December 6, 2024 and are in the physical custody of a NARA's federal records center.
