SUBJECT: Vladimir RODRIGUEZ Lahere -- SP-1693

1. On 30 June 1964, <sup>03</sup> (Vivian Petrosky, WH/SA, called to ask whether I&NS had determined if subject could be a refugee. *NK 7/1*

2. A call to Charles McCarthy, I&NS, reflected that I&NS has decided to keep subject in "SP" status because of his background, but will give him an I-512 whenever it is needed. I&NS will give subject an I-94 so that he will be like any other refugee.

3. I advised <sup>03</sup> (Petrosky) of this decision and that subject should also start processing for an immigrant visa. She said subject's application for immigrant visa was left with Consular Officer, Montreal, when subject left Canada. I asked (Petrosky) to cable Canada and find out if and when the application was filed and send AAS a memo asking that we expedite the visa processing.
