1. Reference is made to the name check request, dated 24 May 1962, subject as above, whose name you desired checked against the files of this office. The files contain the following information concerning the subject of your request.

2. A report dated 19 February 1962 from a usually reliable source indicated that Subject was suspected of working for the Soviet Intelligence Service although he posed as a Pravda correspondent. During a visit to Quito, Ecuador, in January 1962, Subject was in contact with local Communist leaders and with Cuban diplomats. According to the report, Subject and a Cuban diplomat "used" a building housing offices of the U. S. Department of State in Quito.

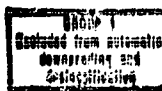
