1. DURING 13 OCT MEETING WITH CORBU<sup>1</sup>STON AMHAWK<sup>2</sup> SAID BENDER GROUP DEALINGS WITH AMRASP<sup>4</sup> AFFILIATES CONSTITUTED INTERFERENCE IN INTERNAL AFFAIRS AMRASP<sup>4</sup> AND STRONGLY EMPHASIZED NEED HE HAVE FULL CONTROL AFFILIATES. DURING CONVERSATION IT OBVIOUS AMHAWK<sup>2</sup> CONSIDERS AFFILIATES AS HIS POSSIBLE SOURCE PRESENT AND FUTURE POLITICAL POWER. CORBU<sup>1</sup>STON AGREED KEEP HANDS OFF AFFILIATES UNTIL RETURN TWICKER<sup>5</sup> AND TWICKER<sup>5</sup> AMHAWK<sup>2</sup> DISCUSSION THIS SUBJECT.
2. MULLER OF DRE MORNING 13 OCT SAID 12 OCT HE HAD ARGUMENT WITH AMHAWK<sup>2</sup> BECAUSE LATTER HOLDING STUDENTS BACK, NOT GIVING THEM OPPORTUNITY PARTICIPATE ACTIVELY IN ANTI-FIDEL STRUGGLE. MULLER INDICATED STUDENTS WOULD PLAY ACTIVE ROLE WITH OR WITHOUT AMHAWK<sup>2</sup>, WITH OR WITHOUT AMRASP<sup>4</sup>. MULLER PARTICULARLY INCENSED RE TREATMENT HE SAYS STUDENTS GETTING FROM AMHAWK<sup>2</sup> AND AMHAWK<sup>2</sup> REMARK TO MULLER THAT HE (AMHAWK<sup>2</sup>) WOULD BE HAPPY RECEIVE STUDENTS

IN CUBA WITH BRASS BAND ONCE STRUGGLE OVER. MULLER WHOSE  
BROTHER JAILED CABANA PRISON RESENTED REMARK PARTICULARLY SINCE  
FEELS AMHAW<sup>2</sup> AND OTHER OLD MEN WILL BE SITTING IN PLUSH  
MIAMI APARTMENTS WHILE STUDENTS AND YOUTHS WILL BE SHEDDING  
BLOOD AND GIVING LIVES IN ORDER MAKE WAY FOR AMHAW'S RETURN<sup>2</sup>  
CUBA. MASH URGED MULLER NOT TAKE ANY FOOLISH STEPS WHICH MIGHT  
LATER REGRET, THAT LEAVING AMRASP IS NOT SOLUTION PROBLEMS.<sup>4</sup>  
MULLER AGREED WAIT LIMITED TIME BUT WARNED HE UNDER STRONG  
PRESSURE BY OTHER STUDENTS AND HE NOT PREPARED LINGER MUCH  
LONGER.

3. RESENTMENT RE AMHAW<sup>2</sup> AND OLD LINE POLITICIANS DESIRE  
GAIN CONTROL YOUNG ELEMENTS THEREBY KEEPING THEM IN INEFFECTIVE,  
SUBORDINATE ROLE APPEARS NOT LIMITED STUDENTS. OPINIONS SIMILAR  
THOSE MULLER EXPRESSED BY OTHER MASH CONTACTS, E. G. HUERTAS,  
ESPIN. MASH FEELS AMHAW<sup>2</sup> RENEGING ON AGREEMENT WITH BENDER<sup>3</sup> RE  
AFFILIATES IS HAMPERING PROGRESS IN PROP FIELD AND HURTING HIS  
POSITION WITH YOUNGER ELEMENTS.

4. MASH PROPOSES HAVE TWICKER<sup>5</sup> TAKE STRONG STAND WITH  
AMHAW<sup>2</sup> ON QUESTION OF AFFILIATES AND TRY MAKE AMHAW ABIDE BY  
AGREEMENT REACHED WITH PARLETT.<sup>3</sup>
