


1. Forwarded under separate cover is a copy of DIR 16720 prepared by IUNOLF following the Central American Student Conference held in San Jose, Costa Rica, in June 1962. It was an oversight that WAZL was not included as an addressee on this cable originally.
 2. The cable is sent to you in order to give you a review of events at the conference, which included AMPMIL representatives. As the conference turned out, the central issue was a resolution on Cuba which divided the delegations 3 to 3 with one—the Guatemalan—undecided. Under considerable pressure the Guatemalan delegation eventually capitulated, resulting in the conference breaking up without a resolution critical of Cuba.
 3. Your attention is called to paragraph 4, mentioning the AMPMIL delegates. These are the comments of the IUNOLF agent, JIGEOLF.
