On about 1 June 1961 Michael Weinstein, Finnish citizen and honorary Italian Vice-Consul in Helsinki, remarked to [Fulton] at a reception in Helsinki that he had heard that Golub, former ~~1st~~ Soviet Consul in Helsinki, had recently divorced his wife, Nina, in Moscow and married a Soviet actress who has a three year old child. According to Weinstein, Golub claims to be the father of this child, a deed of which he was apparently quite proud.

[Fulton] Golub had on several occasions during the 1959 1960 period hinted to [Fulton] that there was an estrangement between him and his wife, Nina, and that he and his wife had been just "friends" for some time. He also mentioned once that his wife, Nina, was having an affair with a Soviet army officer in Moscow.
