SUBJECT: Information from (the British) in Answer to
Question Re Identity of American who
Allegedly Paid Manuel RAY's Fine in Nassau

1. [Chris Phillipotts] called at 1745/12 June 1964 to say that the [Governor of the Bahamas] had replied to our query as to the identity of the American who allegedly paid Manuel RAY's fine in Nassau (see TIME of 12 June 1964, page 48). The [Governor] stated that he saw no such figure and to the best of his knowledge there was no such person. The [Governor] also stated that he was discreetly checking as to whom Manuel RAY called in Miami from Nassau. The [British] will let us know the results of the check. 24
