SOURCE A former Cuban IS officer who served with the Cuban Intelligence Service until April 1964.

Headquarters Comment. The following report is one of a series containing personality information provided by the source and includes supplemental information from the records of this Agency.

Ibrahim VILA is a Cuban Intelligence Service officer of the Direccion General de Inteligencia (DGI - General Directorate of Intelligence) stationed at the Cuban Embassy in Prague, Czechoslovakia. 1

Headquarters Comment.

- The records of this Agency reveal that Ibrahim VILA is probably identical with the General Manager of Cubana Airlines Prague office, Ibrahim VILA Abreu, who made the following trips: departed Habana for Prague on 13 January 1962; Prague for Habana on 15 May 1962; and Habana for Prague on 23 May 1962. He carried Cuban passport number 92237. There is no additional identifiable information in the records of this Agency.
