1. LIFEAT REPORTS THAT MAN GIVING HIS NAME AS DON
 * LOWRY, EVIDENTLY AMERICAN, WAS IN CONTACT WITH
 SOVIET PRESS ATTACHE LEONOV 271-132139 ON 9 JAN AND ALSO WITH
 CUBAN CULTURAL ATTACHE RICARDO ESCARTIN FERNANDEZ SAME DAY.
 LOWRY SAID HE HAD NEWSPAPER AND MAGAZINE EXPERIENCE AND HAD
 ALSO BEEN RADIO AND TELEVISION ANNOUNCER. ESCARTIN FERNANDEZ
 HAD AGREED TO SEND HIS LETTER AND WRITING SAMPLES TO CUBA
 IN NEXT POUCH AND TOLD HIM CHANCES WERE MAYBE TWENTY PERCENT,
 EVIDENTLY OF HIS GETTING A JOB THERE. LOWRY HAS TO WAIT
