THIS REPORT REFLECTED THAT FIDEL CASTRO WAS REPRESENTED BY THE SUBJECT AT A CEREMONY AT GOIAZ UNIVERSITY WHERE CASTRO WAS NAMED SPONSOR OF THE FACULTY OF THAT UNIVERSITY BY THE STUDENTS.

#MS-12029 (352.029) - CUBAN SUBVERSIVE ACTIVITIES ABROAD, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC - REPORT PERIOD 2-15 SEPT. 1961, P. 12

THIS REPORT INDICATED THAT TWO OFFICIALS OF THE MPD, A PRO-CASTRO POLITICAL PARTY IN THE DR, WOULD GO TO CUBA. THEY WOULD BE MET IN HAVANA BY THE SUBJECT.

#MS-12044 - CUBAN SUBVERSIVE ACTIVITIES ABROAD, VENEZUELA. - REPORT PERIOD 11-30 NOV. 1960, P.38

THIS REPORT REFLECTED THAT THE SUBJECT STATED THAT THE VENEZUELAN REVOLUTION WOULD TRIUMPH WITH THE EXAMPLE AND ASSISTANCE OF THE CUBAN REVOLUTION.

On 23 August 1963 the files of the Office of Security, Department of State, were reviewed in the name of the SUBJECT, Rolando CUBELA (Secades), and reflect the following information:

Office of Security, Department of State, File #39-58204, titled Rolando L. CUBELA Y SECALES, contains numerous reports and memoranda from the Federal Bureau of Investigation in the SUBJECT's name. The program dated 27 October 1960 from the Department of State to the American Embassy in Habana reflects that the Department of State concurred on SUBJECT's ineligibility and requested his visa be revoked under section 221 (1) and notify all carriers pursuant to 22 CFR 41.134. The Department requested notification as to action taken by the Embassy in Habana and whether or not the visa was physically cancelled.

An incoming telegram dated 26 October 1960 from Habana to the Secretary of State was in reply to the aforementioned telegram; copies of this telegram were supplied to This Agency.

On 18 November 1960 This Agency, in response to an inquiry from the Department of State, forwarded a report on the SUBJECT.

The SUBJECT's file contains no further pertinent information.

On 25 September 1963 at the Central Office, Immigration and Naturalization Service, Washington, D. C., the following information was obtained from Alien Registration File No. A 12571 698 pertaining to the SUBJECT:

The SUBJECT, Rolando Lazaro CUBELAY Secades was born on 19 January 1933 at Vedado, Havana, Cuba. He entered the United States on 22 November 1956 at Charleston, South Carolina. He resided at 1019 Southwest 24 Road, Miami, Florida.

A lookout was issued by Immigration and Naturalization Service on 18 January 1957, in that the United States Marshal, Miami, Florida, held a warrant for his arrest in extradition proceedings for return to Cuba on charge of murdering the Chief of the Cuban Military Intelligence Service. No further information in this connection was available at this source. Further information may be available from the Federal Bureau of Investigation. It appears that the SUBJECT entered the United States on numerous occasions as a business visitor (B-1); 9 September 1960, New York; 14 August 1960, New York; 7 June 1954, Miami; 31 July 1948, Miami.

A Provisional Operational Approval is granted for the use of this Subject as set forth below.

A Provisional Operational Approval issued by CI Staff grants the same authority, on a temporary basis, for the use of an individual as the authority granted in an Operational Approval unless otherwise specified by CI/OA. It is based, however, only on preliminary file checks and investigation and is subject to a further final review when all investigation is completed.

1. In reference to your 10 July 1963 memorandum, a Provisional Operational Approval is being reinstated for a period of 90 days, until 1 November 1963, and processing initiated for full Operational Approval.

2. While we realize that Subject is in Cuba and out of direct contact at this time, we lack sufficient details about what has transpired in this case to make an assessment for full Operational Approval. The following information should be available at or obtainable by SAS and is desired by CI/OA:

- a. Full PRQ Part I;
- b. Paris debriefing report; and
- c. Field traces: Helsinki, Mexico and Spain.

3. It is also suggested that Subject be given an LCFLUTTER test at the first opportunity, to cover specifically the following points:

- a. Political sympathy;
- b. Connection with other intelligence services; and
- c. Homosexual tendencies (see PRQ Part II).

To process the Operational Approval, full information (completed PRQ Parts I and II) must be submitted as soon as possible and not later than six (6) months from this date. An Operational Approval will follow when all investigation is completed and upon the receipt of satisfactory PRQ Parts I and II. Cancellation must be requested if use of Subject by interested Divisions ceases.

Subject was first contacted for the purpose of assessment on 9 March 1961 in the skvrom of the Hilton Continental in Mexico City. This meeting was arranged by AMWHIP/1 in order for staffer Jack Stewart to exchange views with subject and to open an avenue for future contacts. Conversation was general on the subject of Cuba's problems; no pitch was made.

Subject later expressed wish to talk to "friend of Stewart's" in Europe, and arrangements were made to meet subject in Helsinki. He was met there by staffer William Wainwright and AMWHIP/1. He was debriefed and trained subsequently in Paris by WM and Earl Williamson, DOOS Madrid.
