1. Jean-Claude has been described by some as shy or as one who will not be willing to act the passive role for long. He is not a man to be pushed around, and he is unlikely to be anyone's puppet; while others say he is an idiot, not overly intelligent, a playboy. If the source knows him well, give his evaluation, please. According to the Washington Post, of 10 May, rumors are that Jean-Claude has fled Haiti. Does source have any information?

2. How does the source feel about Duvalier's ability to retain the presidency? To answer the above question, details and logic must be given. Who is or are his chief advisers? Will he accept guidance from his advisers? Will Duvalier be a one-man decision-maker?

3. Please comment on the present relationship between the President and the following:

- a. His Mother
- b. Marie Denise Dominique (his sister)
- c. Max Dominique (brother-in-law)
- d. Col Cande Raymond (Chief of Staff)
- e. Franck Romain (Chief of Police of Port-au-Prince)
- f. Luc Desir (Head of Ton-Ton Macoutes)
- g. Clovis Desiror (Former Minister of Finance)
- h. Garcia Jacques (Commander of the Presidential Guard)
- i. Lockier Cambroune (Minister of Defense and Interior)
- l. Will Cambroune be the strongman in the new government?
If not, who will be?
