MARTHA AGUIAR telephonically contacted the NYO on 3/5/62, and advised that she was presently residing at 340 West End Ave., Apartment-1B, NYC, and desired to talk to the NYO concerning an important matter.

Miss AGUIAR was interviewed on 3/5/62, at which time she stated that she had received two letters from JOSE MANUEL MARTINEZ SIERRA who is the General Manager of Pfizer Corporation in Havana, Cuba. Miss AGUIAR stated that MARTINEZ wrote the letters on 2/8,10/62, and in these letters stated that it was absolutely necessary that she do whatever she could to hasten the request for a waiver visa for him in order to leave Cuba because his situation there was very bad due to his underground activities. Miss AGUIAR stated that MARTINEZ resides at Calle 47, #762 entre Conill y Tulipan, Apartment 5, Nuevo Vedado, Havana, Cuba.

Miss AGUIAR advised that she was furnishing this information in order that the Bureau could furnish it to CIA and to [EARL JAMES WILLIAMSON] who was very close to MARTINEZ in Havana, and who knows what MARTINEZ was doing there.

Miss AGUIAR also advised that in his letter of 2/10/62, MARTINEZ stated that the Pfizer Corporation was finished in Cuba and that for all practical purposes the company had

been intervened by the Cuban Government and that he no longer would be employed by Pfizer as it was necessary to join the militia in order to hold a position there and he, MARTINEZ, would not join the militia. Miss AGUIAR stated that in his letter of 2/10/62, MARTINEZ also stated that he had requested <sup>just</sup> JOSE LOREDO, the General Manager of Pfizer Corporation in Mexico City, to attempt to get a waiver visa for him to leave Cuba, and indicated this request was made of LOREDO in December, 1961, but to this date, MARTINEZ had not received any information regarding his request.

*Mexico*  
On 3/13/62, Miss AGUIAR furnished the NYO with two letters, one from JOSE LOREDO, General Manager, Pfizer International, Mexico City, directed to JOSE MANUEL MARTINEZ SIERRA, Havana, Cuba. ~~The~~ second letter is a letter which was dated 3/6/62, from PEDRO LOPEZ, also known as Pedro of Caibarien, which is intended for CIA Agent EARL JAMES WILLIAMSON. This letter is a request for WILLIAMSON to do something for MARTINEZ SIERRA to get waiver visas for him and his family to leave Havana, Cuba.

*Cuba*  
Miss AGUIAR stated that WILLIAMSON can get all necessary information for the waiver visas from the sister-in-law of MARTINEZ SIERRA, who is Mrs. LUISA DE LAPEZUELA, 2001 North Adams Street, Apartment 815, Arlington, Virginia.

*(U)*  
These letters are being enclosed for the Bureau for transmittal to CIA and for any action they desire to take in this matter. Miss AGUIAR was informed that the Bureau in no way could assist in obtaining a waiver visa for MARTINEZ SIERRA and his family.
