In reference to your request File No. 100-375458, 31 August 1961, our files contain the following information received 23 May 1961. David Graham MC CAMES born 9 March 1925, an American Negro, was teaching at the Cairo University under the name of David DUBOIS. He had a two year scholarship in Communist China but was so "fed up" he left after eight months and is now very anti-Chinese. He did not register at the American Consulate General upon his arrival in Cairo, Egypt. Subject is the stepson of W. E. B. DUBOIS, a well-known American Negro.
