TEPHYAMOVA did not in fact meet GOLLYSWA as previously stated but only knew of her and GOLLYSWA from her parents.

2. Source is quite clear about GOLUBEY's instructions and had not confused the names of GOLITSYN and NOSHNO. GOLUBEY had been sent a directive from lossow setting out his main tasks. This was douched in semewhat rough, direct words in order to put him on the right lines. Source did not deduce from what was in this directive that the K.C.B. believed that either man was living in England. It certainly stated that NOSEMNO had visited England after his defection and that GOLIUSTA had visited England several times. Source knows only what GOLUBEY told him and what was in the directive; he has no idea why the K.C.B. believed that either of the two defectors had visited the U.K.

Para. 3-b : The wording of this paragraph is almost identical
to much of paragraph 3-b of Source's report on Yuriy
Transvich NOSLEND, regarding GOLUGEY's instructions,
EGR belief that both defectors had visited England,
LUT attempts to locate them, etc. The main difference
as given in these reports is that NOBERED is said to
bave been in the UK in 1965, and GOLUTEYN "several
times". Since NOSENNO did not visit the UK in 1965
but we understand that GOLUTEYN did make several visits,
we wonder (in view of the strong similarities in wording)
if there may be a garble in Source's reporting. Boes
Source have any idea as to why the EGE believed either
of the two defectors had visited the UK?
