Effective 1 July 1968 LIFEUD-2, LIFEUD-3, LIFEUD-24, LIFEUD-25 and LIFEUD-26 were granted small salary increases. Also, W. A. PARENSKI was placed on a monthly salary, which replaced the previous hourly pay rate. Amended Memorandums of Oral Commitments were forwarded to Headquarters.

As is normal in this Project, daily operational meetings were held with David M. WILSTED and LIFEUD-24 in order to pick-up LIFEAT production and to discuss various operational aspects involved in the continual maintenance of activities.

#### BASEHOUSES

7. On 19 April 1968 LIRISK employees started extensive renovation work in the area around LIFEAT Annex 6. Because of this, the basehouse was shut down and all of the LIFEAT lines were repaired. This renovation work was completed on 21 June and the basehouse was back in operation in early July.

8. LIRISK work in the area around LIFEAT Annex 8 caused the closure of this basehouse from 19 April until early May.

9. In June 1968 the Station made the decision to close down LIFEAT Annex 5 and move the basehousekeepers, LIFEUD-35 and 36, to another area. The reasons for this decision were two-fold: A) LIFEUD 35 and 36 have four children and Annex 5 was too small for them, and B) the annex needed extensive repairs which the Landrie refused to have done because he was planning to sell the building. A new basehouse, Annex 9, was located and Annex 6 was closed on 20 June. The basehousekeepers are now in Annex 9 and target coverage commenced in early July.

10. Paragraphs 7, 8 and 9 explain the reduced coverage provided by LIFEAT during the three month period under review.

#### SECURITY

11. No known security incidents occurred during this period.

#### PLANS

12. It presently appears that LIFEUD-5, basehousekeeper, will be transferred by his company to the Guadalajara area. If this occurs, we will accept the resignation of LIFEUD-5 and -15 and close down Annex 3. In view of this, Project Officers presently are looking for replacements and Operational Approvals will be requested as soon as suitable candidates are located.

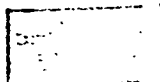

1. In accordance with Reference, Subject was granted an OA on 22 November 1966 to permit the WH/7/Haiti Desk to utilize Subject as a Creole translator of unclassified tapes. Subject was recruited in December 1966 and has been performing this function satisfactorily since that time.

2. It is now requested that Subject's OA be amended to permit WH/7/Haiti Desk to utilize his services to translate sensitive telephone tapes (LIFEAT) from the Spanish, French and Creole languages into English. To date the Mexico City Station has been providing Headquarters with a translation of the Spanish and French portions of this intelligence take, with Port-au-Prince Station assisting with translation of the Creole portions. Recently, however, the Port-au-Prince asset departed Haiti and, at present, neither Station has the capability to translate the Creole portions. Since it is believed that the Creole portion may contain important operational information from a CI standpoint, the Haiti Desk proposes to utilize Subject to fulfill this gap. Subject will be polygraphed before he is given this added task. Your expeditious attention to the above request would be appreciated.

1. REF A PROVIDES BACKGROUND ON DECREASE IN SALARY OR TERMINATION PROPOSED TO LIFEUD-1.
2. ON 1 JUNE 67 LIFEUD-1 OPTED FOR FINAL TERMINATION. DURING DISCUSSIONS THIS MATTER WITH WILSTED, LIFEUD-1 FRIENDLY AND SAID HE REALIZED HE RECEIVING TOO LARGE A SALARY FOR WORK HE PERFORMING. SAID HE DECIDED ACCEPT TERMINATION BECAUSE A) WANTED TO IMMIGRATE TO WOLADY, B) DID NOT DESIRE USE HOME AS BASEHOUSE, AND C) AFRAID OTHER PERSONS INVOLVED IN LIFEAT WOULD LOOK DOWN ON HIM FOR ACCEPTING REDUCTION IN SALARY. The purpose of this project is to provide unilateral telephone tap coverage in Mexico City. A U. S. Career Agent serves as Outside Case Officer and personally handles the thirteen sub-agents who are responsible for the technical phase of the Project which is run out of seven basehouses. A Station Case Officer directly handles five translators who are also funded out of this Project.

B. Funding History

1. The Career Agent (GS-13) receives his salary and allowances split between bank deposits in the United States made directly by Monetary and a field allotment received from the Station. He pays the thirteen sub-agents their salaries which total \$2,337/month, basehouse expenses (rent and utilities), and ops expenses. The Station Case Officer directly pays the five translators their salaries (total \$1,675/month) and expenses. All equipment is furnished by CIA and is replaced when necessary.
2. Funds have always been handled in this manner.

Please furnish this Station with a revised LIFEAT Project TVA with a total of 7 (seven) vehicle authorizations, more than now listed on the TVA, if this increase is deemed necessary for the continuing transportation allowances, all leave reimbursement paid to 6 of the project agents as approved by reference B.

2. Paragraph I. 2) d. of the project renewal request forwarded by reference C included an annual amount of \$500.00 each for the use of LIFEAT-6, LIFEAT-8, and LIFEAT-24 RV's; \$400.00 each for the use of LIFEAT-5 and LIFEAT-7 RV's; and \$300.00 per year for mileage reimbursement to Carol K. HENNINGER. These agents have been paid these amounts over the years in accordance with project approvals. However, in view of the FM-45-35 and FM-23-5 regulation revision in August 1964, which established the requirement for a TVA slot for RV's used on a continuing basis, the question of the need for a TVA is raised to preclude a possible audit exception.

3. The RV's are used by the agents in transporting tapes and other material between various operational points. Daily use averages from 20 to 50 miles per day and from 1 to 4 hours per day depending upon the assignment. Use of pooled vehicles is not possible because of the widely separated points of contact, the need for simultaneous use and the impracticability of coordinating the use of pooled vehicles from a cover standpoint. Public transportation is not practical again because of the widely separated points of contact and government transportation cannot be used because of cover.

1. Headquarters records indicate that Project LENOX was terminated 30 June 1965 as reported by reference B. WILSTED and MV-2539 were both transferred to Project LIFEAT. An amended TVA was forwarded to the Station by TM #0561324, dated 9 July 1965.

2. The establishment of a transportation allowance is predicated on a reduction in the number of Organization vehicles and a savings to ODYONS. Considering vehicle depreciation over a period of several years and charges for gas, oil and maintenance, it is deemed economical for ODYONS to pay the transportation allowance of \$50.00 per month. The availability of a POV, which is intended primarily for personal transportation and used only incidentally for official use, makes it advantageous for the employee to receive a transportation allowance.

3. In the case at hand it is noted that 90% usage of a vehicle by WILSTED, representing 1500 miles per month and a proposed \$80.00 per month transportation allowance, is for official business. Since the vehicle is used almost exclusively and very extensively for official use, it seems more appropriate, as well as to the advantage of ODYONS and WILSTED, that it should be an official vehicle.

4. Headquarters appreciates Station desire to reduce the number of QP vehicles. However, each case must be decided on the basis of the circumstances involved and, particularly, ODYONS interest. We request that the Station reconsider this case before we submit it to higher authority for approval.

1. Authority is requested to pay David E. WILSTED a transportation allowance of \$70.00 per month for the use of a POV for official business. It is planned to dispose of W-2539, a 1962 Chevrolet Escalade 4 door sedan that has been driven for approximately 50,000 miles in favor of a transportation allowance for WILSTED. The vehicle has been used for a total of 30 months with mileage averaging 1,665 miles per month, 90% of which was official business travel.

2. The recommended transportation allowance is based on costs computed as follows:

3. A prorated allowance is not based solely on extraordinarily high costs, although insurance costs are relatively high in Mexico City, but rather the great number of miles traveled by WINTER every month in connection with WINTER and cover domestic business. If WINTER were to be reimbursed on a mileage basis at 24¢ per mile, he could be paid approximately \$144.00 per month based on past mileage. WINTER will agree to an \$26.00 a month allowance in lieu of the mileage rate with the understanding that a periodic review of use and costs will be made, with resultant adjustments of the allowance if necessary.

4. Since WINTER will have to purchase his car in Mexico because of his cover status, he will have to pay an estimated \$25,000 over the factory recommended retail price, approximately \$3,200 for the 1965 Ford Falcon, 4 door sedan he plans to purchase. It is requested that Headquarters advise in regard to the factory recommended retail price as of August or September in ZENITH on the above described vehicle, equipped with white side wall tires and radio, to facilitate the computation of the Station contribution to offset the higher cost of the vehicle in Mexico. This amount less the prorated depreciation will be recoverable at the time the vehicle is disposed of.

5. Considering the amount recoverable upon the disposal of the vehicle, the cost to WINTER will be the same or less than the cost of shipping a RV to an overseas post, and will therefore be comparable to the costs of many staff employees overseas who use their RV's for official business.

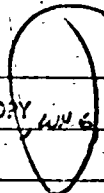

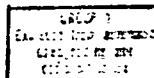



1. Headquarters approves the suggestions made in reference for adapting the ZONAR format to LIENVOY needs. The Station will use the first two columns for numbers running from 01 to 30 to designate the recording machine on which the material was received, and the 6 spaces in column three will be used for the dossier number assigned the target. Under this system, the Station has room for expansion up to 999,999 targets. The name IN, name OUT, and telephone number columns will be the same for LIENVOY as for the system applied to LIFEAT/ZONAR abstracts.

2. Headquarters has several questions on the remaining columns.

a. First of all, will the Station have the ZONAR abstract sheets filled out in Spanish or English? If the runs appear in English, they will be of limited value to the Mexicans; if they appear in Spanish, the Spanish and English abbreviations for the same Subjects will not fall together in alphabetical consolidated runs for the subject type runs. (See paragraph 3 below.)

b. According to paragraph 3 and 6 of reference the Station wants the following LIFEAT ZONAR listings every two months:

**CONCEALMENT - BOOKCASE**

Work Order 2176

(CDB-106)

A bookcase 47" x 48" x 12" was made with a concealment area. The bookcase was made from pine and painted flat black. The concealment area is 1-5/8" x 10-1/2" x 45" and is located under the bottom shelf and covered by the kick panel.

The kick panel must be opened in order to gain access to the concealment area. This panel is held in place with a positive locking device. The locking device is located under the front-center section of the bottom shelf. It is located beneath a filled nail hole. The locking device is released by inserting a table knife blade - or similar piece of metal - between the bottom shelf and kick panel and, pushing toward the rear of the case, a distance of approximately 2", at the above-designated point. To facilitate inserting the blade on a loaded shelf, lift upward on the center part of the bottom shelf until the lock releases. When the lock is released, the kick panel may be moved by pressing inward on the bottom edge of the panel. After the panel has been moved slightly withdraw the knife so that the under surface of the shelf is not marked; then complete opening the panel. It is important that the kick panel not be forced beyond its maximum opening point approximately 70 degrees from vertical.

To close the panel, return it to its original position by pressing inward on the top edge until the lock snaps into place. Test for locking by pushing inward on the bottom edge.

1. Reference requested serialization of the Mexico City telephone directory by street address. The matter was discussed with the Headquarters units concerned with this type of work. Due to the time required to complete this job and because of the existing heavy work load, they are unable to undertake this requirement. The requirement could be filled by another government agency after the directory was reduced to abstracts based on a numerical coding system. The outside agency would then punch the coded addresses and indices onto cards at a cost of \$75 per thousand or \$6,250 for 110,000 addresses. A full time person with a knowledge of Spanish would have to be assigned by WHD for this work.
2. The major part of the job would be the first step—the coding—which it is estimated would require a person's full time for eight to ten months. The second step—the key punching—would take about two months. The third step—a machine listing—would be a fairly rapid process.
3. Because of the cost and the shortage of personnel, Headquarters regrets that it is unable to undertake the serialization job at this time.
