## REMORANDUM

PHONE CALL FROM JIMMY JOHNSON REGARDING FERRIE AND THE SMITH CASE (January 10, 1967, 4:00 P. M.)

It is to be noted that Jimmy Johnson who was once a close associate of Ferrie, but broke free from Ferrie but as a favor for this office, renewed his friendship with Ferrie for information purposes for this office.

Jimmy stated that Ferrie had contacted Pershing the other day in regards to the Cuban woman's name that was mentioned in the Saturday Evening Post urticle.

That Ferrie had called a Lawyer (name unknown) last uight which would be January 9, 1967, and upoke with the lawyer about his being investigated by this office. Details of conversation unknown.

Ferrie has a lot of old army paraphernalia in his apartment, such as, walkie talkies, incendiary bombs, etc.

Terrie was showing nude pictures (moving films) to two young boys and a district police car shined a light on his front porch and he really became frightened and uncontrol-lable, telling Jimmy that the police must anapect him.

Jimmy stated that one Steve Littleton parked a twincongine beachcraft in Ferrie's spot at the airport, and that
their plume was flown in from out-of-town. It is at Ferrie's
disposal. He also heard Ferrie and Littleton taking about a
little island somewhere and they were interested in knowing if
they could land the beachcraft on this island.

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Jimmy feels that they may have taken a smaller alrplane and flew so this island today to look at a possible landing spot.
