Phillip Geraci, was in Carlos Bringuier's store when LHO came in and offered his Marine manuel.

Subject reiterated his Warren Commission testimony, changed one point—subject states Vance Blalock (whereabouts unknown to date) mentioned that LHO asked Carlos Bringuier if he was a member of the (Cosa Nostra)—subject feels the name asked was Casa Roca, the store operated by Carlos Bringuier. Subject was a C.A.P. cadet for approximately one (1) year—62-63, didn't know David Ferrie, and had little or no contact with senior group headed by Ferrie.
