To protect NY 694-S* we have not furnished foregoing to British (New York is affording Franks intensified coverage in New York. There is no information in this office, however, to indicate that MI-5 is now aware that PERRY is incclose contact with Chinese Communist elements in London (\$)

MI-5 has been recontacted re activities of subjects while in England and as of 12/11/63 Mr. STEWART MC CALLUM, MI-5, advised that they had no additional data to furnish at this time. All information known to this office coming from MI-5 has previously been furnished to the Bureau. (\$\)

Before proceeding further with this particular investigation, in view of information contained in relet, Legat, London suggests that no further action should be taken with MI-5 at this time and that this office await results of New York investigation which may uncover additional information from another source which would enable Legat, London to then recontact MI-5. These cases will be maintained in pending status awaiting results of New York investigation.
