Dear Sir:

The records of this Service show that Sam Deiner, probably the subject of your report, was admitted in transit from Montreal and departed from New York City to Nevene on February 12, 1961. His address was shown as 4190 McKenzie Avenue, Montreal. He was again admitted in transit at Miami, Florida on September 20, 1962 and departed from Miami to Havans on September 23, 1962. At that time his address was shown as 890 Fraser Avenue, St. Lawrence, Quebec. was also admitted at Miemi, Florida, in transit to Canada on September 29, 1962. This record reflects his address as 890 Frazer Avenue, Quebec.

These records show subject as a Canadian citizen, born February 7, 1916 in Montreal and as traveling with Canadian passport #5020934.

Consola Information received from our office in Burlington, Vermont reflects that Sam Beiner errived as a passenger with passport \$5020934 in Toronto, Canada on World-wide Special Charter Flight from Havana on April 11, 1962 and again on Cubane Airlines Charter Flight #176 on June 1, 1962.

Dear Sir:

The records of this Service reflect that Samuel Fink, believed to be the subject of your memorandum, became a U.S. citizen through naturalization in the Supreme Court of New York at Watertown, New York on August 10, 1943, while a member of the Armed Forces. At that time he had his name officially changed from Samuel Finkelman to Samuel Fink. Our File C5 770 326 indicates his correct name was Szmul Finkielman but that he commonly used Samuel Finkelman. There is no indication that he ever used or was known by the name of Som Benton. He was described as having a ruddy complexion, blue eyes and dark blonde hair. His height was shown as 6' 12" and his weight as 150 pounds.

At the time of his naturalization Mr. Fink stated that he was born in Ludwipol, Wolyn, Poland on July 4, 1920. He claimed that he first errived in the U.S. in 1939 at New York City as a stowaway, coming from Cuba. Prior to his induction he resided at 14 Oxford Street, Portland, Maine and was employed as a shoemaker by the H.E. Davis Company at Freeport, Maine. He was inducted on June 20, 1942 and his Army Scrial Number was 31117079. He was lawfully admitted to the U.S. at Calexico, California on March 10, 1943 while on active duty in the U.S. Army.

During interrogation in 1941 he stated that he traveled as a stowaway Canal from Poland to France, and France to Cubs in 1935, and from Cubs to Panama in 1939. He stated that the only time he was ever arrested was for being a stowaway, when he arrived in Panema in 1939; that he was kept in jail about one month and then deported to Cuba.
