Records of the German Federal Republic show that Marina Oswald crossed West Germany en route to Holland on June 3, 1962. On June 26, 1962, Oswald stated he and his family left Holland on June 4, 1962 on the SS "Maasdam."

## June 13, 1962

According to records of the Immigration and Naturalization Service, Oswald, his wife, Marina, and daughter, June, arrived in New York on the SS "Maasdam." During an interview on June 26, 1962, Oswald advised that he arrived in Dallas, Texas, by air, on June 14, 1962.

There is no record of any foreign travel on the part of Oswald following his arrival in the United States until September, 1963. In the intervening period, Oswald worked at a variety of jobs in Texas and Louisiana. In September, 1963, Oswald was living in New Orleans.

## Trip to Mexico

## September 17, 1963

Oswald applied for and received Mexican Tourist Card 24085 at New Orleans. It was issued in his correct name and carried his correct address. The handwriting on the application has been identified by the FBI Laboratory as Oswald's. He presented a birth certificate as proof of citizenship, claimed to be taking three hundred dollars into Mexico, and said that he intended to travel by bus. The tourist card issued was an in-transit card indicating that his travel in Mexico was for the purpose of transit-
