The Division of Recovery deploys H&SS Field Coordinators tasked with conducting mission scoping assessments of post-disaster impacts to health and social services systems in the affected states and territories to determine and quantify the type and level of enhanced recovery support through the RSF. The nine core mission areas of the H&SS RSF are: public health, healthcare services, environmental health, behavioral health, food and safety and regulated medical products, social services, referral to social services/disaster case management, long-term recovery impacts to first responders, and children in disasters (schools, children, and youth).	
	If the mission is conducted pursuant to a mission assignment issued under the Stafford Act, closure is on the last date of performance period of the mission assignment. In the event the mission is a Non-Stafford Act event, closure is on the date the Secretary's Operations Center closes the incident for reporting.
