1.	<p><u>Japanese-American Redress Records</u></p> <p>Section 105 of the Civil Liberties Act of 1988 authorized the Attorney General to identify, locate, and when appropriate, make payments of \$20,000 to eligible individuals of Japanese ancestry who were evacuated, relocated or interned during World War II.</p> <p>Case files established as a result of the Act are identified as Classification 146-CLA (Civil Liberties Act), followed by a sequential number for each case. The file consists of written notification to the individual, correspondence from the individual, and other supporting documentation acquired in the identification and determination of eligibility. Each case is closed by a letter of ineligibility, or a payment document.</p> <p>^{PERMANENT.} Disposition: Transfer closed cases semiannually to the Washington National Records Center (WNRC). Destroy in the year 2001. Transfer to the National Archives on January 1, 2002.</p> <p>Mr. Bernard W.
