1	<p><u>Declaration of Intending Citizen (Form I-772)</u></p> <p>The Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986 required that for an alien to be covered under the act as an "intending citizen," he/she must have completed INS Form N-315, "Declaration of Intention," or INS Form I-772, "Declaration of Intending Citizen." The Immigration Act of 1990 changed the designation "intending citizen" to "protected individual" and eliminated the requirement that aliens complete a declaration of intention to become a U.S. citizen. This change was made applicable to unfair immigration related unfair employment practices occurring before, on, or after November 29, 1990. The Code of Federal Regulations, 28 C.F.R. § 44.101 removed the filing of the I-772 from the definition of "charge." These changes are retroactive and the filing, or not filing, of an I-772 has no bearing on the completeness of any charge filed with this office. 1986-1988, approx. 20 CF.</p> <p>Temporary.
