**Background Information** 

The Accident/Incident Database System (AIDS) was developed to be the official system of record for all Accidents and Incidents (A/I) investigated by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). AIDS contains relevant data concerning aviation A/I, that also serves as a centralized electronic repository of information used by internal and external stakeholders. AIDS supports FAA and industry needs for Risk Based Decision Making (RBDM) efforts. In addition, AIDS supports the FAA Pilot Records Database, by providing A/I reports to air carriers, with the Airman's permission, on A/I events they were involved with.

This system is necessary to support the mission of the FAA, by sharing A/I related information and investigation reports. Upon the occurrence of an aviation accident or incident, an FAA Inspectors-In-Charge (IICs) investigates and collects information relating to the accident or incident. The information gathered is entered into the reporting tool, the Air Traffic Quality Assurance (ATQA) system to electronically complete FAA Form 8020-23, FAA Accident/Incident Report. Once completed, the data from the 8020-23 is transferred into the system of record, the AIDS database.
